FARM DOG CERTIFICATION TESTS - OPEN TO ALL BREEDS

The AKC Farm Dog Certified (FDC) Test is open to all dogs <u>at least 9 months of age</u> that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers, or neutered dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Females in season may not participate. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to enter provided, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the entire course.

ENTRIES OPEN Wednesday, September 6, 2023 at 8 AM. Please do not send early entries; they will be refused.

Entries Close: Wednesday, October 25th, 2023 at 7:00 PM at the home of the event secretary

If the test event does not fill by October 25th, 2023 at 7:00 PM, we will accept day of entries.

After October 25th 2023, entries cannot be, canceled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Regulations for Herding Tests and Trials.

FDC Entries Limited to 35 runs per event.

Day of Show entries will be accepted, if maximum limit is not reached on or before Wednesday, October 25th, 2023.

ENTRY INFORMATION - FARM DOG TEST

ENTRY FEES: Pre-entries: \$40/PER DOG/per RUN, includes AKC \$3.50 recording fee. Make checks payable to Shetland Sheepdog Club of Georgia, Inc.

Day of entry fee will be \$45/per dog/per test; cash only. Day of entries will be taken until 11:00 AM provided there is space available in either test. Please note it takes two test passes to earn the title, so cost is per test.

If sending entries overnight, make sure to sign the waiver that allows the delivery person to leave packages without a signature. Requiring a signature will only delay receipt of your entries. Checks will be deposited on Thursday, October 26, 2023. Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry and will be subject to a \$35 collection fee.

Errors and Illegible Entries: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print clearly & carefully the information on entry forms to eliminate errors. The Event Secretary is not responsible for illegible (in the opinion of the Event Sec) entry form information. The Shetland Sheepdog Club of Georgia, Inc. may decline entries and may remove any dog on any account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against the aforementioned group or any official or member thereof.

Confirmations: Confirmations and judging schedule will be sent by email only. Final confirmations will be emailed after the entry closing date.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered test, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. **Refunds will only be allowed for bitches in season**. Bitches in season will not be admitted to the test. Any exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the test date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3.50 per test for the AKC recording fee, upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the event secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on the day of the test. (Saturday, November 4, 2023) If because of riots, civil disturbance or acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the Test, no refund will be made. When entry limits are reached, all additional entries received prior to closing will be added to an alternates list in the order entry was received. The alternates list will be used to fill vacancies that occur in the drawn running order, with the first alternate entry replacing the first vacancy in the event entered.

Consent and Release: A signed Consent and Release from Liability form must accompany each entry. Failure to do so will result in you and your dog being barred from entering the grounds and competing in these tests.

PRIZES: Each dog that passes a Farm Dog Certification Test will receive a dark green qualifying ribbon provided by the Shetland Sheepdog Club of Georgia, Inc. Dogs earning their Farm Dog Certification will receive a title rosette provided by the Shetland Sheepdog Club of Georgia, Inc.

Dogs that pass Farm Dog Certification Tests under two different judges are eligible for a Farm Dog Certified Title. The Shetland Sheepdog Club of Georgia, Inc. will provide an application form for this title. A link to this application form is also on page 6 of this premium.

Owners will need to complete the application form and send it and the appropriate fee to the American Kennel Club; the Shetland Sheepdog Club of Georgia will not do this submission for exhibitors, but will help FAA and 4-H students with the form.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE: Mackerras Hollow is a private residential farm located at 1701 Juliette Drive (NOTE: synonymous with "Juliette Road" on some maps). From US-78 West - take exit 5 to East Ponce De Leon / Memorial Drive; bear right onto E Ponce de Leon Ave. From I-285, take US-78 East and use exit 5 towards Stone Mountain Village/Memorial Drive (7.6 miles from 285/78 junction); bear right onto E Ponce de Leon Ave.

Turn right on E Ponce de Leon Ave, and then at the first light turn right on Juliette Drive. Proceed past the apartments and over the bridge to the end of the road (X miles). The farm is located on the right at the dead end and directly across from DeKalb United Pentecostal Church.

PARKING INSTRUCTIONS: Parking will be available. Please follow the directions/signs on the day of the event.

HOSPITALITY: Lunch and water will be provided for all volunteers.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- TEST 1: Check in will begin at 8:00 AM. Judge's briefing at 8:15 AM. Tests will begin at 8:30 AM.
- TEST 2: Check in will begin at 11:30 AM. Judge's briefing at 12:00 PM. Tests will begin at 12:15 PM.
- The exhibitor can not have food or treats in their possession during the test.
- Dogs must wear a secure, well-fitting, <u>flat collar</u> during the test evaluation and be held on a proper fixed-length leash at all times while on the farm site unless confined in a crate, kennel or vehicle. The leash shall be four to six feet in length. No prong or electronic collars, head halters, harnesses or flexi-leads are permitted on the premises.
- NO FLEXI-TYPE RETRACTABLE LEASHES ALLOWED on site.
- You are responsible for picking up after your dogs and disposing of waste in the proper receptacles.
 A failure to do so could result in you and your dog being dismissed from the testing grounds and be barred from competing.
- Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting herding stock nor to interfere outside the testing area with another dog's performance in the test areas. The Judge may request the removal of any dog from the immediate test area at any time, if she determines the presence of the dog presents a risk to livestock, other dogs or persons on the farm.
- Un-entered dogs are NOT allowed in the test/trial areas or on the grounds.
- Entered Dogs allowed on Mackerras Hollow grounds in area of test only.
- Please do not leave ANYTHING in the parking area.
- Bitches in season may not enter.
- No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same judge at any Test.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor the Course Director will be responsible or obligated to furnish any services for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging.
- The Groups sponsoring these events, the course director, their agents, officers, club members and committee members shall assume NO RESPONSIBILITY for injury or illness to you, children or dogs. YOU ENTER AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- By attending this event, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19 and any communicable disease related to humans and canines.
- All dogs must have current vaccinations for rabies, distemper, parvo. Please bring a copy of rabies certificate or current tag with you.
- These tests are held on private property. You must obey all posted rules.
- Children must be accompanied by and kept under the direct supervision of an adult at all times.
- Please follow parking directions.
- Please vacate the premises upon completion of the tests.
- Bring your own chair and shade and water for your dogs. Dress appropriately for the weather.
- There will be no concessions available on site for exhibitors.
- Event is held rain or shine.
