**BONUS 1 pt for a dog who competes in all five venues**

Dogs receiving qualifying scores in performance events will be awarded 2, 3, or 4 points as appropriate for their class, but do not receive the participation point as well. The participation point in performance events is awarded only if the dog competes but does not qualify in the event. Dogs competing in multiple classes at the same event will be credited with the highest placement received in any one class only.

Dogs who make a cut or earn placements and awards in breed competition will be awarded 2, 3, or 4 points as applicable to the award, but do not receive the participation point as well. Dogs who make multiple cuts in a class will receive the same two points as dogs who make one cut. Dogs excused from the breed ring shall still be awarded a point for participation. Dogs disqualified from the breed ring shall not be awarded a point for participation. In the event of a tie, event scores shall be used to break the tie. The dog with the highest total score will receive the award.

The official catalog markings taken from the judges' books for each event shall be used to determine eligibility, participation, placements and official scores.

## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS AND ATTENDEES**

When you enter or register for any event at this show or are on the defined show grounds of the fairgrounds or any of the performance trial venues, including the host hotels and parking areas, you automatically agree to the following rules that have been established for the benefit and pleasant enjoyment of the event by all parties:

1. No puppies under six months of age are allowed in any area of the hotels or events grounds
2. No grooming or bathing of dogs in hotel rooms. There will be bathing facilities at the show site
3. No un-entered dogs in the show area
4. No breeding of dogs or whelping of bitches at the show site or hotel
5. No dogs left in exercise pens overnight
6. For sale signs are prohibited
7. One dog per crate
8. All crates must be stackable. No soft-sided crates permitted at the conformation site
9. Plastic sheeting must be under all crates in hotel rooms
10. Dogs must be crated whenever left unattended in hotel rooms
11. Dogs must be kept on lead at all times when walking in hotel, grounds or show site
12. Exercise dogs in designated areas ONLY; and PLEASE clean up after your dog
13. Flash photography is not permitted ringside
14. Cell phones must be turned off or on vibrate at ringsides. Please leave the area to use your cell phone
15. No smoking indoors or within 25 feet of any performance trial ring or doors
16. No tripods located ringside
17. No saving seats at ringside

## **ATTENTION EXHIBITORS**

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to acceptance. Telephone, telegraph, incomplete or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC herding entry forms or photo copies of the official AKC herding entry form without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC herding entry form cannot be accepted. The American Shetland Sheepdog Club of America, Inc. assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information provided by the owner or the owner's agent on the entry form. If sending entries overnight, make sure to sign the waiver that allows delivery without a signature. **ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED, CANCELLED, ALTERED OR SUBSTITUTED AFTER ENTRIES HAVE CLOSED**, except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Regulations for Herding Tests and Trials.

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for the herding test or trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any herding test or trial for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his or her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC (for complete rule refer to Chapter 14, section 3 of "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows")

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge or barred from participation by the Trial Committee. If it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. Entries will not be accepted without entry fees. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check from the same exhibitor and may result in the exhibitor's entries being accepted on a cash only basis.

The American Shetland Sheepdog Club of America, Inc. and Woods End Farm assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their dogs on leash (except when in the arena or stock dogs when working) and under control at all times. Dogs must be kept a suitable distance from the test/trial area. Dogs may not be left overnight. Exhibitors MUST clean up after their dogs. We would like to be able to use this facility for future test/trials. Proof of current rabies vaccination must be furnished on request.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. And I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
