## What is Treibball???

Treibball (pronounced "try-ball") is a fast-growing competitive and recreational dog sport where your dog drives oversized inflatable exercise balls into a goal using their nose or body. Often referred to as "urban herding," it is open to all breeds and provides excellent mental and physical stimulation. Competitive leagues and rules are formally managed by organizations like the [American Treibball Association](#).

Originating in Germany, Treibball simulates herding but doesn't require live livestock.

- **The Setup:** Up to eight large exercise balls are arranged in a triangle formation (like racked billiard balls) at one end of a field.
- **The Handler's Role:** You stay in a designated "handler zone" near a soccer-style goal.
- **The Goal:** Using only verbal cues, whistles, or hand signals, you direct your dog to go *behind* the balls, turn around, and push them one by one into the goal within a set time limit (usually 7 to 15 minutes)
